#### **Ordinances and Resolutions**

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cape Coral, Florida, approving Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. CON-UT18-15MC between the City of Cape Coral, Florida, and Vanguard Utility Service, Inc. to extend the term of the Contract for a period of six months and include the installation of potable water meters, sizes and ranging from 5/8" to 2", for the installation of potable water meters at new customer service connections, in the estimated amount of \$133,890, not to exceed budgetary limits; authorizing the City Manager or their designee to execute the amendment and purchase order(s).

### **Summary Explanation and Background**

On May 14, 2018, Council adopted Resolution 103-18, awarding Contract# CON-UT18-15MC to Vanguard Utility Service, Inc. for professional services for the City's deployment of manual/touch read meters to Neptune E-Coder Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) technology, as well as outdated radio read meters services. The contract was for a period of three years, commencing on May 18, 2018, through May 17, 2021, with the option of two additional two-year renewals. On October 2, 2019, Amendment #1 was executed adding services for 1-1/12" and larger potable water meter exchanges.

On April 7, 2021, Council adopted Resolution 67-21 for Contract Renewal #1 for an additional two years from May 18, 2021, through May 17, 2023.

On May 3, 2023, Council adopted Resolution 87-23, for Contract Renewal #2 and Amendment #2 to extend the contract for an additional two-year period from May 18, 2023, through May 17, 2025, and adding services for 5/8" potable water meter installation.

Staff is requesting approval of a contract extension for a period of six-months or until a new contract is signed, whichever occurs first, to allow time for the procurement process to be finalized.

Staff is requesting approval of Amendment #3 for installation of potable water meters, sizes ranging from 5/8" to 2" at new customer service connections based on the unit price quoted in an estimated amount of \$133,890 not to exceed budgetary limits.
