A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO CONTRACT NO. CON-UT18-15MC BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, AND VANGUARD UTILITY SERVICE, INC., TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS AND INCLUDE THE INSTALLATION OF POTABLE WATER METERS, SIZES RANGING FROM 5/8" TO 2", FOR THE INSTALLATION OF POTABLE WATER METERS AT NEW CUSTOMER SERVICE CONNECTIONS, IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$133,890, NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETARY LIMITS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT AND PURCHASE ORDER(S); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 103-18 on May 14, 2018, which approved Contract No. CON-UT18-15MC with Vanguard Utility Service, Inc. to provide professional services in exchanging the City's system-wide deployment of manual/touch read meters for Neptune E-Code Automatic Meter Reading technology; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 was approved October 2, 2019, which authorized additional services to include 1-1/12" and larger potable water meter exchanges; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 67-21 on April 7, 2021, which approved Contract Renewal No. 1 for an additional two years, from May 18, 2021 through May 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 87-23 on May 3, 2023, which approved Contract Renewal No. 2 and Amendment No. 2, to renew the contract for an additional two-year period and to provide additional services to include 5/8" potable water meter exchanges; and

WHEREAS, Staff is requesting approval to extend the contract for a period of six month, or until a new contract is signed, whichever occurs first, to allow time for the procurement process to be finalized; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the Mayor and City Council approve Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. CON-UT18-15/MC with Vanguard Utility Service, Inc. to extend the contract for a period of six months, and to include the installation of potable water meters, including sizes ranging from 5/8" to 2" at new customer service connections, in the estimated amount of \$133,890, not to exceed budgetary limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council hereby approve Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. CON-UT18-15/MC with Vanguard Utility Service, Inc. to extend the contract for a period of six months, and to include the installation of potable water meters, including sizes ranging from 5/8" to 2" at new customer service connections, in the estimated amount of \$133,890, not to exceed budgetary limits. A copy of Amendment No. 1 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager or their designee to execute the amendment and purchase order(s).

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

AMENDMENT #3 5/8" & 1" POTABLE WATER METER EXCHANGE PROGRAM CONTRACT # CON-UT18-15/MC

This AMENDMENT #3 ("Amendment") is made to the Contract between the CITY OF CAPE CORAL (CITY) and VANGUARD UTILITY SERVICE, INC. (CONTRACTOR) located at 1421 W. 9th Street, Owensboro, KY 42301 for the 5/8" & 1" Potable Water Meter Exchange Program dated May 17, 2018.

Extension:

The Contract is hereby extended for an additional six-month period, through November 17, 2025, or until a new contract is signed whichever occurs first. Previously executed Amendment 1 and Amendment 2 to Contract CON-UT18-15/MC will remain in effect. Additionally, installation of potable water meters, sizes ranging from 5/8" through 2", at new customer service connections is authorized based on the quoted rates provided in Exhibit A.

The following provisions are hereby added to the contract:

PROHIBITION AGAINST CONSIDERING SOCIAL, POLITICAL, OR IDEOLOGICAL INTERESTS IN GOVERNMENT CONTRACTING:

In accordance with Florida Statute 287.05701 the City may not request documentation of or consider a vendor's social, political, or ideological interests when determining if the vendor is a responsible vendor. An awarding body may not give preference to a vendor based on the vendor's social, political, or ideological interests.

E-VERIFY VALIDATION:

As a condition precedent to entering into this CONTRACT and in compliance with The Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), 8 U.S.C. Section 1324a(e) Section 274A(e) and Florida Statute State Section §448.095, Contractor or Consultant and their subcontractors shall register with and use the E-Verify system to verify work authorization status of all employees hired after January 1, 2021. The Employment Verification System (E-Verify) is operated by the Department of Homeland Security in partnership with the Social Security Administration.

A public agency must require in any contract that the contractor, and any subcontractor thereof, register with and use the E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all new employees of the contractor of subcontractor. A public agency or a contractor or subcontractor thereof may not enter into a contract unless each party to the contract registers with and uses the E-Verify system.

Contractor must include E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Verification document.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in effect. If and to the extent that any inconsistency may appear between the Contract and this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall control.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING:

Pursuant to Florida Statute 787.06, when a contract is executed, renewed, or extended between a nongovernmental entity and a governmental entity, the nongovernmental entity must provide the governmental entity with an affidavit signed by an officer or a representative of the nongovernmental entity under penalty of perjury attesting that the nongovernmental entity does not use coercion for labor or services as defined in F.S. 787.06.

Except as set forth in the Amendment, the agreement is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is a conflict between the Amendment and the Agreement or any earlier amendment, the terms of this Amendment will prevail.
