#### **Title**

Resolution 146-25

#### **Ordinances and Resolutions**

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cape Coral, Florida, increasing the purchase order to Tetra Tech, Inc., from \$200,000 to \$385,000, for disaster emergency debris removal monitoring services, as a result of Hurricane Milton; authorizing the City Manager or their designee to execute purchase orders, change orders and any related documents.

Note: Increase is due to the original dollar amount only being an estimate of the services required for debris monitoring services after Milton. The scope did not increase.

Department: Public Works

Dollar Value: \$185,000 (Disaster Fund – cost covered by the Public Assistance Grant)

## Summary Explanation and Background

On October 30, 2024, Council adopted Resolution 368-24 which authorized the City Manager or designee to execute all procurement related purchase orders in excess of \$100,000 pertaining to Hurricane Milton.

This amendment is to reflect the estimated amount of \$385,000 for debris removal monitoring services with Tetra Tech and request authorization for the City Manager to execute a purchase order or change order. The original estimated amount requested was \$200,000; however, with work now completed, the new estimated amount is \$385,000. Tetra Tech has submitted additional invoices for the storm related efforts for a total cost to date of \$377,752.61, plus an estimated \$4,000 for remaining data analyst work and expenses not yet billed.

The cost will be submitted to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for reimbursement through the Public Assistance Grant, as part of the Hurricane Milton recovery project.
