Summary Explanation and Background

The Fire Service Assessment was established in 2014 and provides a dedicated funding source for the costs of fire protection services and facilities for each ensuing fiscal year. Chapter 17 of the City Code provides a uniform process for the imposition and annual administration of Assessments imposed to fund essential services and capital improvements, including the assessments imposed by the City each year.

The Assessment imposed provides an equitable method of funding the annual costs related to fire protection services by fairly and reasonably allocating such costs based on the special benefit derived.
