

FIRE PROTECTION ASSESSMENT FINAL RESOLUTION 243-25 AUGUST 27, 2025



Fire Protection Assessment

- 1. Introductory Resolution 206-25 was approved on July 23, 2025, authorizing the City to notice assessed property owners.
- A. Notices were sent out first week of August to assessed property owners.
- B. Resolution 243-25 represents the final resolution for Fire Protection Assessment.



Fire Protection Assessment

Purpose- provides a dedicated funding source for the cost of fire protection services and facilities for the upcoming fiscal year

Assessment is based on a two-tiered methodology:

- Tier 1- all parcels (including vacant) share in the cost of readiness to protect - this is a fixed assessment
- Tier 2- improved parcels only; based on structure value (not taxable value) expressed as Equivalent Benefit Units (EBUs)



Assessment Calculation-81% Recovery

Fire Protection Assessment

Some Key Investments in Fire Protection funded by the Fire Protection Assessment include:

- 1. Fire Station 5 Rebuild \$9.5 million
- 2. Direct Exhaust System \$1.375 million
- 3. Staffing Additional 19 positions
- 4. Facilities Maintenance to Various Stations \$635,000
- 5. Generator Replacements & Docking Stations \$810,000
- 6. Rescue Truck \$390,000
