- Surfside Potable Water, Wastewater, and Irrigation Improvement Area established August 27 2007
- North Central Loop Potable Water, Wastewater, and Irrigation Improvement Area established December 3, 2007
- Southwest 6&7 Potable Water, Wastewater, and Irrigation Improvement Area established December 3, 2007
- North 2 Potable Water, Wastewater, and Irrigation Improvement Area established August 2 2017
- North 1 West Potable Water, Wastewater, and Irrigation Improvement Area established March 22, 2023
- Del Prado Mall Parking Lot Assessment Area established August 27, 2007
