Ordinances and Resolutions

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cape Coral, Florida, approving the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Non-Ad Valorem assessment roll for assessments to collect certain previously exempted North 1 West Irrigation Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments; approving the amounts, and providing for collection of the assessments pursuant to the Uniform Assessment Collection Act; and providing for an effective date. (Brought forward by City Management)

Requested Action Approve or Deny

Summary Explanation and Background

The North 1 West Utility Expansion Project included connection to and assessment of water, sewer, and irrigation. Of the 3,812 properties connected to irrigation services, twenty-two (22) properties were incorrectly coded in the system. Although services were provided, these parcels were mistakenly entered into the system as being within 75 feet of a potable well, which would normally prohibit connection. When properties are coded this way, the City is responsible for paying the assessment until the parcel, previously on well water, is connected to municipal water. Due to this coding error, the property owners did not receive notice about the irrigation assessment, and the City paid the November 2024 irrigation installment on their behalf.

The miscoding does not exempt the property owners from paying the assessment. Utilizing Chapter 17 of the City Code which provides a uniform process for the imposition and annual administration of Assessments imposed to fund essential services and capital improvements, the City will assess the property owners for the original amount due on March 22, 2023 for a term of thirty (30) years, plus interest and any associated annual collection costs the City incurs.
